was shared among participants so this knowledge could be taken back to communities throughout Atlantic Canada.

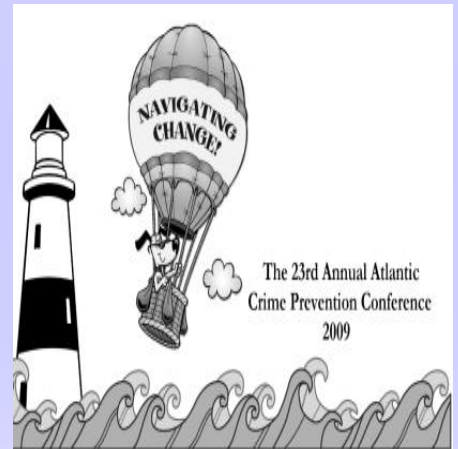
Promising practices in crime prevention were showcased, and an emphasis on Aboriginal culture was highlighted.

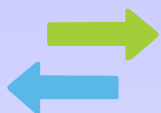
